Charming Mas Marin in the Aix countryside, with private swimming pool and view of the Mt Saint Victoire mountain.

If you want to spend holidays with family or friends, in the historic capital of Provence, Aix-en-Provence, a nugget of heritage and culture, lulled by the gentle Provençal way of life?

This authentic Provençal Mas, surrounded by nature and a few minutes from the heart of the city of water is ideal to fulfil your desires and consider precious moments of relaxation with family or friends, with in addition, a superb view of the Mt Sainte Victoire made famous by Cézanne his greatest inspiration

Located in the Aix countryside, a stone's throw from the typical village of Puyricard and 10 minutes from the centre of the magnificent city of Aix en Provence 6km, this elegant Provençal Mas built in the heart of a 1 hectare property planted with Mediterranean species delicious smells of Provence guaranteeing a stay full of calm and serenity offers a bonus view of the Sainte Victoire mountain.

Designed with noble and authentic materials, the residence offers bright living rooms, shade and light at all times, pleasant volumes, and noble materials. Its four beautiful independent bedrooms with their bathrooms, allow everyone to preserve their tranquillity.

Here one can imagine an art of living where simple pleasure, combined with comfort, dominates.

The outdoor spaces, here in Provence, are privileged and reside essentially in the harmony between vegetation, swimming pool area, and shaded terraces which border the house.

Large grassed areas surround the huge grounds that offers a view of the Mt Ste Victoire, a mountain dear to Cézanne, and lets the imagination wander far away.

Here and there, many nooks and crannies to recharge your batteries, to experience moments of reverie, calm, sharing and conviviality under the sweetness of our beautiful Provence.

You can enjoy the south-facing terrace, as soon as the fine weather arrives, under the pleasant space shaded by a pergola and its tiled roof, complete with garden furniture.

It extends to the front of the two suites on the ground floor, set back a little, for more privacy. Shaded by a natural pergola which gives it a summery and charming touch, it blends into the decor. You can lounge on a deck chair or read a book in the sun.

You can plan to share breakfast or meal, on a hot day under the patio, or to enjoy the South / West facing terrace covered by an awning.

You may not believe it, but there is something magical about lazing around or sharing a game of cards, an aperitif or another moment of relaxation in the shade... when the sun is at its zenith! From the living room, direct access on the north side invites you to do so.

Aix en Provence the beautiful tree-lined avenues of the university town are less than 6 kilometres away from this Bastide, with lots of shops and restaurants, heritage sites and museums dedicated to the many famous artists who have flocked to this area.

Aix is the birthplace of Cézanne, and his greatest inspiration was Mont Sainte Victoire, which is clearly seen from this villa near Aix-en-Provence. In 1958, Pablo Picasso, himself inspired by the works of Cézanne, bought the Chateau de Vauvenargues at the foot of Mont Sainte Victoire and this became his resting place upon his death in 1973. The chateau has recently been opened to the public in the summer months

Activities & Leisure:

Aix was the capital of Provence in the 15th century: prosperous and notable merchants made the city the Provençal Florence that we know today. Bourgeois residences, flowered squares, mansions, old fountains, shaded alleys... all the images of noble Provence from the 17th and 18th centuries are brought together in Aix.
The big names in literature or painting have been inspired by the charm of the city: Guigou, Stendhal, Mistral, Zola and Cézanne. Here, everything is colours and sensations: light from the sky, golden stone of the facades, transparent green of the fountains, shade of the plane trees, surprises from the nights of the festivals; Aix en Provence is an invitation to travel through time. Source of life, captured and distributed since antiquity, water is at the heart of the city and its history. All admirers of Cézanne are well aware that it is here that we feel the painter's presence most intensely;
"I go to the landscape every day, the grounds are beautiful and I spend my days more pleasantly than anywhere else." Letter from Paul Cézanne to his son (A route stamped with the letter C crosses Aix and allows visitors to visit the places where the painter lived).

A city of art and culture, Aix has a rich architectural heritage that has been superbly restored and maintained. With 140 listed historical monuments, the city of Aix en Provence is the richest in heritage after the city of Paris.
Living in Aix on a daily basis means being able to benefit from a wide range of sporting and cultural activities: from the oldest to the very young, the list of possibilities is lon

Historic capital of Provence, Aix perpetuates ancestral habits and customs around public events or family celebrations. This culture happily combines tradition and today's creativity, thus asserting an identity, that of Aix and more broadly that of Provence.
Let's follow the guide and explore Provence together: The pretty and rich city of Marseille, Cassis famous fishing port , the surrounding sites and villages, nest of several "Most Beautiful Villages of France", the Baux de Provence, Arles la Romaine, the Camargue, the Luberon, and so many other mythical places are at the end of the road.
