Additional local information;

Just south of Lisbon this part of Portugal's coastline offers a stunning expanse of un-spoilt sandy beaches within a picturesque rustic scene where rice farming, fishermen and salt makers still abound.

The region has been a popular holiday haunt for Portugal's oldest families as well as a few others in the know for many years, such as French designer Jacques Grange and the Monegasque Royal family who come here to enjoy some low key luxury. During the high summer in Comporta, there are parties galore hosted by hip beach clubs as well as a range of reasonably priced typical restaurants to choose from. If you prefer a quieter holiday and cooler temperatures, book your villa vacation outside the high season when the region is just as charming and there is also plenty to explore nearby.
