Description

Nestled within the green hills of Umbria's capital city, Perugia, Villa Gioiello is a restored 14th century church that, though no longer consecrated, continues to dedicate itself to the well-being of its guests. While its three-floor structure has been updated to provide modern luxuries and conveniences, many of its originally built stone walls have been kept and exposed, thereby continuing to endow the villa's spacious interiors with a sense of enduring stability and comfort. Outdoors, thanks to an abundance of furnished gathering spaces, including its terraces, pool area, and garden, the villa makes it easy to enjoy panoramic views of Perugia's lush countryside. Enjoy Villa Gioiello with loved ones and dine together al fresco here, in Umbria, the "green heart" of Italy!

On the ground floor there is no lack of spaces for getting together, as this floor offers three living rooms: the first living room was once a chapel, and features a white interior and high wood-beamed ceiling, sat TV, and comfortable seating; the second living room is part of an open-concept plan that combines it with the dining room, and comes with sofas and a dining table, and opens towards a terrace; and the third living room features plush seating and a fireplace. The kitchen is well-equipped, bright and spacious, and features a breakfast nook as well as access to the kitchen's outdoor garden, complete with a breakfast table and parasol. Near the kitchen are also a spacious laundry room and a guest bathroom.

Outside the expansive fenced and landscaped villa garden is available for your enjoyment. Experience relaxing moments at the private pool 5 m x 11 m, and on the pool deck, furnished with a parasol, sun beds and chairs. A wood-decked terrace with a sofa and chairs is perfect for snapping a few pics for Instagram with your favourite drink in hand. Facing the living room is a terracotta-tiled furnished terrace which includes a dining table with seating for up to 8 for al fresco dining. A BBQ is also available. A shaded breakfast table in the garden provides an ideal location for beginning the day.

SPECIAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Villa Gioiello offers plenty of gathering spaces and amazing views for enjoying time together. The villa is part of a family-owned estate that is surrounded by rivers, fishing lakes, a waterfall, castles, and the estate's restaurant about a 10-min drive. The estate offers a wide variety of activities, from yoga classes and massage treatments, to hunting wild boar, in autumn, trail hiking and 18-hole golfing. Nearby are a small village with shops 10 min, and the famed towns of Perugia 25 min and Assisi 40 min, among many others. Florence and Rome are also within reach, each about a 2-hr drive away.

Due to its proximity to Tuscany, any traveler who goes from Florence to Rome by land should pass through Umbria. This region is worth a visit of its own for the beautiful landscapes and enchanting lakes. Several filmmakers found it to be the perfect location for movies such as *The English Patient*, *Life is Beautiful* and *Under the Tuscan Sun* (despite its namesake). Perugia is the capital city and is renowned for hosting the annual Umbria Jazz Festival, held in July, and the Eurochocolate Festival at the Perugia Chocolate Factory, in October.

There are several notable tourist attractions throughout the region. Lake Trasimeno, the fourth largest lake in Italy, offers a plethora of activities for the sporty vacationers. The medieval town of Deruta has been producing hand-made majolica ceramics for centuries and it is the ideal place to buy some home decor to bring home. Check the Ceramics Museum on the hilltop main piazza. Spoleto is arguably one of Umbria's most beautiful hill towns, and renowned host of the Festival dei Due Mondi (Festival of the Two Worlds), annual summer music and opera festival held each June to early July. You may also want to sample the Umbrian wine along the Sagrantino Wine Road near Spoleto and Montefalco, which is lined with wineries, many of them open for tastings.

Assisi is the birthplace of St. Francis, where you can enjoy a visit to the Basilica di San Francesco which is listed as a world heritage site by UNESCO. Last, but not least, is Orvieto known for its wine (Orvieto Classico, a dry fine white wine) and because it is one of the main centres of Italy's Slow Food. Do not miss to visit its magnificent Duomo, considered the most glorious example of Italian Gothic style.

WHERE TO EAT;

Ristorante Apollinare - A 12th century church near the Roman theatre. A fun, warm place to enjoy good food and international wines. Via S. Agata 14, Spoleto - +39 074 322 3256

Il Duca d' Orvieto - Traditional Umbrian cuisine based on regional products, reinterpreted by its owner. Do not miss the home-made desserts! Via della Pace 5, Orvieto - +39 076 334 4663

I Sette Frati - If you do prefer an authentic homey atmosphere, (if you cannot find it, ask around for Signora Marisa's restaurant). Fantastic (yet very simple!) trattoria, local cuisine with a very reasonable prix-fix menu. Do not be discouraged by the decor, come with a big appetite and be ready to eat the dishes of the day (there is no menu). Relax, enjoy, and Signor Mario will take care of the rest. Ristorante Buca di San Francesco - A family run restaurant where the menu features classic dishes of Umbrian cuisine, paying special attention to meat and mushroom dishes. WHERE TO SHOP;

Food – a street market is held every Thursday and Saturday in Orvieto's Piazza del Popolo. Buy some lentils, one of the local food specialties to bring home. This legume with its characteristic thin and tender skin, is the flagship product of the country par excellence.
