Halfway between Camargue and Alpilles in the countryside, surrounded by fields of hay, this magnificent Provencal Mas will seduce you with its authenticity.

Dating from the 19th century, this old building was erected with exposed stones and has been completely brought up to date, taking care to preserve its soul and its charm of yesteryear. Authentic and quality materials have been chosen by the owners to guarantee you comfort and relaxation for your holidays under the Provençal sun.

Upon entering the Mas Mandine, you will immediately be seduced by the ground floor completely renovated with cement tiles, by the floor tiles of the staircase, by the stone walls or by the oak ceilings.

Let yourself be seduced by the beauty and authenticity of the place!

The Mas consist of 450m² of accommodation on 2 levels with 5 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms, 1 shower room and 5 WC. Independent fitted kitchen, dining room, living room, TV lounge and a pantry/laundry room.

Outside the grounds of 1 hectare of parkland and a magnificent lawn, huge century-old plane trees, majestic pines, cypresses, so many species that will immerse you as soon as you arrive in the universe of Provence.

This lush vegetation goes perfectly with the beauty of the building, all in exposed stone and highlights the huge heated 12m x 6m swimming pool which is at your disposal.

The exterior has been designed to allow you to spend pleasant moments in the different spaces offered, according to your desires, and the position of the sun.

You will enjoy a moment of relaxation in the small summer lounge area, after spending the afternoon in the solarium area of the swimming pool.

Several terraces will offer you moments of calm and conviviality and perfect for outdoor al fresco dinning with barbecue and the plancha will allow you to vary the pleasures of long summer dinners.

Avignon to the north with its UNESCO world heritage site, with it's magnificent Palais du Papes, which is one of the architectural wonders of France is just 12 kilometres away and would make an ideal day trip. Just north of Avignon is the Châteauneuf-du-Pape region for wine lovers as well.

Les Baux de Provence is considered 'one of the most beautiful villages in France, Arles, Nîmes not far away, Pont du Gard and Uzès and other towns you can easily visit in a day, and at less than 45 minutes' drive and to the east is the Luberon region and Camargue's at your door step unique wetland

populated by pink flamingos and wild horses and the famous port of Saintes-Maries de la Mer and its stunning beaches all within 30 minutes drive

Activities & Leisure:

- A vast natural environment to explore: After visiting the sumptuous Abbey of Montmajour, you enter the Alpilles. Dominated by the site of Les Baux de Provence, the luminous massif is surrounded by sunny and peaceful villages, where, between vineyards and olive trees, Provence, eternal and dreamy, defies time...
- An exceptional fauna and flora, which, protected by the Nature Reserve and the Regional Nature Park, make it a nature sanctuary, an inexhaustible site for hiking, biking, mountain biking, in which you can discover a vast choice horseback riding, and the wild nature of the Camargue with the National Ornithological Reserve (its pink flamingos, its horses, etc.).
- A rich historical heritage: The discovery of Arles is a walk through time to discover its architectural treasures listed as World Heritage of Humanity. (The amphitheater, the theatre, the cryptoporticoes, the Alyscamps, the thermal baths, the church and the cloister of St Trophime), but also not far from there, other monuments (the palace of the popes of Avignon, the arenas of Nîmes, the Pont du Gard...),
- Majestic rivers: In Arles, the river delta opens up. Its two arms, the Grand Rhône and the Petit Rhône, are navigable, offering fluvial tourism the most unprecedented of discoveries in the Camargue.
- An interesting cultural heritage: Its language, its Museon Arlaten, created by Frédéric Mistral, its costumes, its Queen, its Arles women make Arles the capital of Provençal culture. This tradition, maintained by many groups, is shared by enthusiastic crowds during the festivals of Arles: the feast of the Gardians, the election of the queen, the satin race, the Pegoulado, the costume festival, the beginnings of rice, the international exhibition of santonniers, etc.
- A hectic festive season: Traditional celebrations, Easter Feria, lyrical shows, “les Suds, à Arles” music festival, peplum film festival, etc.

This dream region combines all the advantages. Artists and poets were not mistaken in choosing to reside there (Pagnol, Cézanne...). All the cities there (Arles, Avignon, Nîmes, etc.) evoke the sun and the singing accent, the beaches of Saintes-Maries de la Mer, the Camargue cruise, the Vaccarès and the Camargue symbolise freedom and wild nature.

The Alpilles, to the northeast, extend over 25 km dominated by the site of Les Baux-de-Provence. This mountain range is surrounded by sunny and peaceful villages between vineyards and olive trees (Fontvieille with Alphonse Daudet's mill and its horse and carriage rides, Saint-Rémy, Avignon and the Palais des Papes, Nîmes and its arenas, the bridge Gard, Arles and its culinary specialties...). The central and famous points are St Rémy and Les Baux, very popular villages for hiking. The Alpilles are made up of scrubland, rocky ridges, a tormented but fairly low relief and many typical villages of Provence
