Walking through the narrow streets of the city and bewitched by its beauty, few can imagine the gems that hide on its rooftops. Standing within the heart of the medieval city's centre, and inside a historical palazzo, Rustici is one of those gems: a beautifully renovated penthouse duplex that provides more than just a luxury accommodation to those who want to visit the city; in fact, if you can handle the almost 90 steps to reach the apartment, you will be rewarded with having Florence at your feet! Rustici is designed on two floors, a lower floor which comprises the bedrooms and bathrooms, and the upper floor which includes the social space and kitchen, all timeless and yet contemporary. Here at Rustici, you will be wrapped in comfort and indulgent luxury, not to mention gifted with a 360-degree view of Florence.

The living space is bright and beautifully, decorated living room welcomes you on the top floor of the apartment, via a set of 15 steps with a wrought-iron handrail. The elegance of this space is dramatised by its beamed ceilings, large windows with flowing curtains, classic blond-wood furniture and romantic white upholstered seating. Most importantly, this beautiful room features two terraces – each on opposite sides – where guests can enjoy a meal or a drink while marvelling at the spectacular sunsets. The fully equipped kitchen blends smoothly with the rest of the room, and the what may be for some 'boring' chore of cooking now feels instead fun-filled thanks to the room's vibrant atmosphere and sensational views. A washer and a dryer are also available in the unit.

WHERE TO EAT;

La Giostra - serving Tuscan Cuisine where the highlight is Chianina Tagliata, a kind of carpaccio that goes into the oven with garlic, rosemary and bay leaf. The charismatic Soldano, owner of the restaurant and Prince of Hapsburg Lorena, makes the dining experience unique by welcoming you in person in this romantic venue where the motto is still "in food we trust". Trattoria Sostanza - Informal and modest place, up to 35 seats with communal dining, no menu in English, and an essential – almost unattractive - décor that should not discourage you to try the food...every dish is thick with flavour.
